



SEED CATALOGUE 2020

Greetings seed enthusiasts!

Once again we have prepared our seed catalogue and are excited to be sending seeds out for spring planting...

We are currently reviewing how we manage the seed catalogue, particularly in regard to varieties of vegetables that are not necessarily suited to the Southern parts of New Zealand (for example many of the Central American beans), and trying to bulk up the varieties that we do know are well suited. As we have been sent a lot of seed from other parts of New Zealand we still want people to be able to access these, but are only keen to have them returned if they perform well in the southern half of the South Island, particularly in coastal regions. These can be found in the second part of this catalogue. The format of this catalogue has been tweaked slightly too, and everything is now listed by Latin family name, so check carefully if you can't see something you're after.

As always, Beginner seeds are available to everyone at \$1 a packet and Guardian seeds are those that we ask only experienced seed savers to request and we make them available for free. If you do request Guardian seeds, we would appreciate you sending as many seeds back as possible. The varieties that most need bulking up are listed with a YES in the seed saving column. Below is a small list of varieties that have 'fallen off' the catalogue, as seeds have not been returned over the years. If you have any of these, again we would much appreciate them being bulked up and sent back, as well as any other seeds you have that you think others should be growing!

If you have grown anything from our catalogue in the past and can provide feedback on how well or poorly they performed (regardless of whether or not you saved seed from them) we would highly value this information. This will assist us to further strengthen the collection for the future. We will be putting out an online survey within a few weeks to look more into this too.

Below you will find the catalogue and an order form. Feel free to send the order form in via email or post and we will get seeds back to you as soon as our volunteers can put orders together.
